

**Autonomy** means the desire to direct our own lives. At DMP, when we behave well, we earn autonomy and we are trusted to do things independently.

It is up to class teachers to decide when they think a child has earned their next autonomy badge.

Autonomy badges can also be removed by teachers and they have to earn them back over the course of the term.
